I write to inform you that CUHK is offering an International Summer School (ISS) from 28 June to 2 August 2010. You and your fellow schoolmates are cordially invited to join the Programme for an unforgettable summer in Hong Kong – Asia's world city.

The ISS is an intensive Programme which allows one semester of work to be condensed into five weeks. As students and teachers hail from all over of the world, the ISS provides an excellent opportunity for students to internationalize themselves while gaining professional growth at CUHK. While attending, students will not only appreciate Asian cultures first hand and learn in a multi-cultural environment, but also make new friendships with people from diverse cultural backgrounds.
